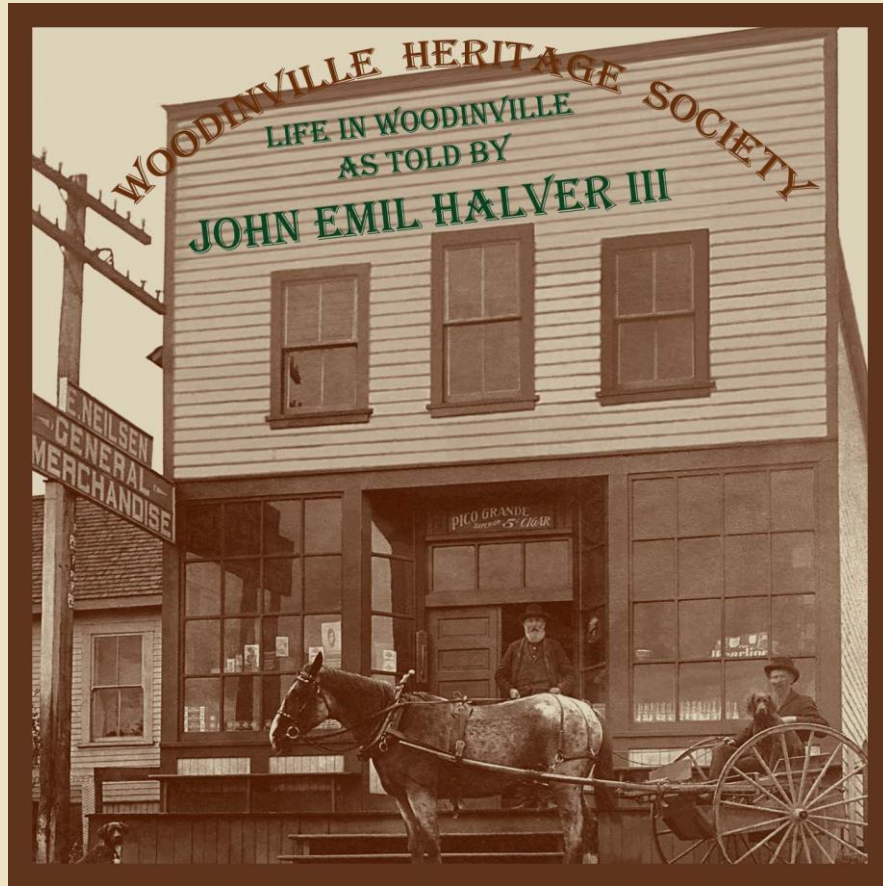


Life in Woodinville DVD: *John Emil Halver III*



Dr. John Emil Halver III

John was born in 1922 above his great-grandparents' store (shown on the cover) located in the first business district in the Town of Woodinville.



His great-grandparents Emanuel & Greta Neilson immigrated from Norway to America in 1864 and homesteaded 160 acres in what is now the City of Woodinville in 1874. His grandmother Mary B Jaderholm Hansen also homesteaded another 160 acres and platted the original Town of Woodinville in 1890.

Dr. Halver is a pioneering scientist in fish nutrition, physiology, cellular biochemistry, and metabolism. He earned his Bachelors & Masters degrees at Washington State University and a Ph.D. at the University of Washington. His international work for Food & Agricultural Organization, United Nations Development Program, World Bank, US Aid to Developing Countries, and the International Executive Service Corps has spanned 30+ years of effort to assist populations in developing countries to improve their food supply.
